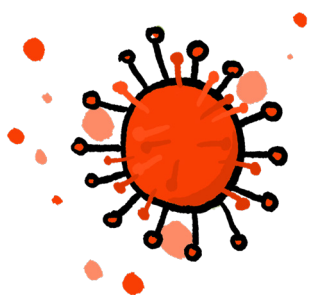

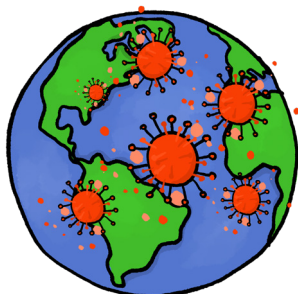

COVID-19 or **Coronavirus** is a new disease.

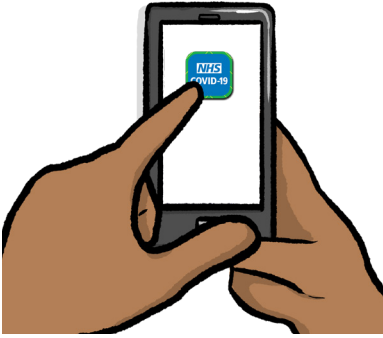


Pandemic means it is spreading around the world.

NHS COVID-19 app



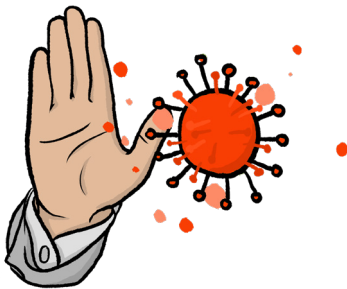
We are asking everyone to start using the new NHS COVID-19 **app**.

Download the app



Everyone living on the Isle of Wight, who is over the age of 16, should download the NHS COVID-19 app.



Our Easy Read leaflet will tell you more about the app and how to download it onto your phone.

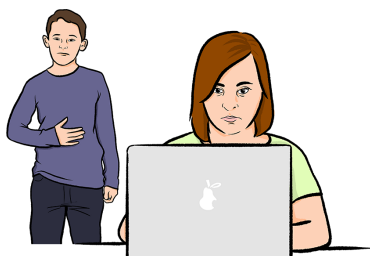


When you have the app, it can tell you what to do if you think you may have Coronavirus.



You may have Coronavirus if you have one or both of these things:

- a high temperature
- a new cough and you keep coughing
